CALL FOR ENTRIES

About the Awards

Each year, the American Society of Military Comptrollers (ASMC) recognizes the outstanding accomplishments of its Chapters, membership and the defense financial management community through the awards program. The program encompasses individual, team, scholarship and chapter program recognition. Awards, with the exception of scholarships and grants, are presented at the National ASMC Professional Development Institute and recipients are recognized in the *Armed Forces Comptroller* and on the ASMC website.

The Categories

ASMC recognizes individuals for outstanding accomplishment within the functional fields of comptrollership through the **Achievement Awards** program. This award category closes on 1 February 2017.

Subcategories include:

- Accounting
- Acquisition and Cost Analysis
- Auditing
- Budgeting
- Comptroller/Deputy Comptroller
- Contractor Support
- Finance
- Intern/Trainee
- Resource Management
- Small Team
- Large Team

The **Chapter Leadership Award** is designed to recognize individuals for outstanding leadership, accomplishment, and support of the society at the chapter level. This award category closes on 10 April 2017.

This **Corporate Member Award** recognizes Corporate Members for outstanding contributions made to a local Chapter and the National Organization in the furtherance of the goals of the chapter and the society, as well as efforts in promoting the professional development of ASMC members. This category closes on 10 April 2017.

The **National Scholarship Program** provides financial assistance for qualified high school students. This award category closes on 31 March 2017. Any high school senior who plans to enter a field of study related to financial/resource management (business administration, economics, public administration, computer science, or operations research related to financial management, accounting, or finance) may apply. Nominations must be endorsed and submitted through local ASMC chapters, who may forward two nominations to the National Scholarship Program.

ASMC provides financial assistance to aid members in their efforts to continue educational pursuits, under the **Member's Continuing Education Program**. This award category closes on 31 March 2017. Any active member who wants to pursue further education in a field of study related to financial/resource management may apply.

To increase authorship within the membership of the society, ASMC offers the **Essay Award**. This award category closes on 28 February 2017. All ASMC members in good standing are eligible to enter this annual competition. This year's essay topic is the question "If the President nominated you to serve as Comptroller/Chief Financial Officer for the Department of Defense, what would you target as your three most important financial management goals and why?"

How to Submit

3. Submit your form, including all files uploads.
4. You will receive a confirmation email with your completed entry information.
